


Workshop on Patient-Reported Outcomes and Vision Related Quality of Life Questionnaires

The Workshop on Patient-Reported Outcomes and Vision Related Quality of Life Questionnaires is a virtual workshop that will be held on September 29, 2023, (Friday) from 10 am to 4 pm EDT. The purpose of the workshop is to highlight the importance of patients' perspectives, patient-reported outcomes ("PROs"), and questionnaires to measure visual function and vision-related quality of life ("VFQs") in vision research and clinical care. The goal is to identify future steps in the development of PROs and VFQs for a variety of ocular conditions and varying degrees of visual impairment. The workshop is open to the general public to tune-in as attendees, and it is anticipated that researchers from academia, industry, non-profits, other government agencies, patients and care partners will attend.
